The Eagle Woolen Mills, of Brownsville, commences over 325,000 pounds of wool per year and over 700 cords of wool. They employ an average of fifty-five hands, at a cost of over \$25,000 annually. The Thos. Kay mill of Salem, uses from 340,000 to 400,000 pounds of wool per year, consumes 800 cords of wool, employs fifty-seven persons, and pays \$20,000 per year in wages. This country does not grow half the wool consumed, and yet we sometimes wonder what the future of sheep husbandry is to be.—The Huntington, Indiana, Breeders Guide.
