Whether soybeans are planted in rows, drilled or broadcast, the best results are obtained from cultivation just ahead of planting. It is well to remember that the destruction of large numbers of weeds then will insure a higher yield of clean soybeans at harvest time.

Undeveloped Rich Market Less than one-fifth of feathers produced on chickens ever reach any commercial market. America in the past had to depend upon importations, while her own products were being destroyed. Feathers are the only fiber or coating of any animal or fowl in America that is not being fully utilized for the war effort.

Among the new uses developed for North, Range 28 East of the feathers is as a foundation for protein plastics. Satisfactory surgical sutures or sewing material has been made from feathers. Waterproof glue made largely from feathers is also on the market. It has also sibility.

Experiments are being conducted to turn chicken feathers into yarn. For feminine frills and decorations, certain types of feathers bring as much as \$3 a pound on the market. of Victory Square. into material to keep the armed forces warm. Fiber board has been made from compressed feathers and is said to have exceptionally good insulation as well as soundproofing

Feathers have long been valued as fertilizers, but with recent developments it is believed they will serve a more important function.

Defrost Often

For economy of operation, defrost often; frost thicker than a quarterinch acts as insulation, increasing operating costs. Cool all cooked foods before storing is another thrift hint. For quick defrosting turn the current off, removing ice cubes from freezing trays (they may be temporarily stored in a bowl), fill trays with hot water and replace. This causes the accumulated frost to melt quickly, after which the ice cubes may be returned to the freezing trays and the current turned on again for normal operation.
